

School Uniform

Thank you for your support in helping us maintain high standards with our school uniform.

BOYS: Red jumper with school logo, school tie, white shirt, grey trousers or shorts, grey/black socks, black shoes - no trainers or boots please

GIRLS: Red jumper/cardigan with school logo, school tie, white shirt, grey skirt/pinafore /trousers, grey/red tights or white socks. Red gingham dress in the summer. Black shoes no trainers or boots please. Hair bobbles in school colours

PE Kit: White T Shirt, Red/black shorts, plimsolls or trainers, plain tracksuit in the winter for outdoor PE, Holy Trinity hoodie optional. Hoodies are only worn on PE days and are NOT part of our main school uniform so should not be worn instead of a tie and jumper on non PE days.

Jewellery: No jewellery other than an ordinary watch (not a Smart watch) and stud earrings are allowed in school; and these need removing on PE days.

Please make sure that all uniform is labelled clearly with your child's name - thank you!
